The original bank building on Lancaster Avenue was built in 1923.¹ The extension was built in 1957. The car in the center of the upper picture is a Ford Fairlane. Behind it at the drive-in teller is a 1956 Chevrolet. Also notice the fire tower in the left background. The Fire Station was located to the west side of the bank building until 1977.
